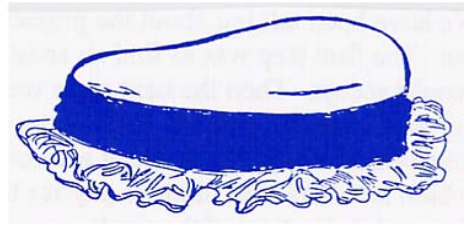

Annual Fund Drive 2010

Dear Fellow Alumnae:

It is with pleasure that I write to you and ask that you give every consideration to making a philanthropic, tax deductible gift to the MGHNAA when you renew your annual MGHNAA membership dues of \$30 this year. By design, the MGHNAA Board continues our dues at a minimum so many of our alumnae can join. With that said, it is our hope that you will consider an additional \$100 philanthropic contribution this year.

For those alumnae who are not members, please consider joining the MGHNAA at \$30 annually— a bargain – as you know. The additional support of 500 new active members will add nearly \$18,000 to our bottom line. This revenue will help with our publications, the *Record* and *Beyond the Cap*, office and mailing expenses, web site support, MGH Homecoming and the Continuing Education Day, Scholarship and Loan Program, grants and awards, and the alumnae medical expenditure fund. This is primarily a volunteer organization with minimal compensated services so you can be assured your funds are directed toward our MGHNAA initiatives.

This year we increased our support for the Sleeper, Corkum, and Huggard awards to \$5,000 each to help aspiring, young nurses and experienced senior nurses seeking advanced education. In addition the MGHNAA increased the funding to support our Scholarships and Loans Program for fellow alumnae. With your support we established the *Massachusetts General Hospital Nurses' Alumnae Association Endowed Fund* at the MGH Institute of Health Professions MGH Institute School of Nursing including the new Staats Scholarship Award, and at the MGH Department of Nursing as a lasting tribute to our beloved MGH School of Nursing.

The MGHNAA has been actively collaborating with the MGH Department of Nursing preparing a historical book depicting the history of nursing and the MGHSON as part of the MGH 2011 Bicentennial Celebration. You will be enormously proud of this pictorial publication.
