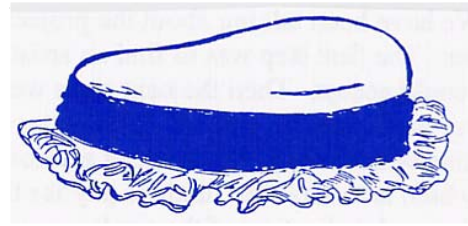

This is a look at nursing over the 200 years compiled by a small group of dedicated volunteers, many from the Alumnae Association.
